

Dear Valued Customers,

Beginning Monday, September 13th, by order of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO), proof of partial vaccination, at least one dose, will be required to access some programs and services offered at the Powell River Recreation Complex. As of October 24th, customers must be fully vaccinated to participate. It is anticipated that this requirement will be in place until January 31, 2022 and could be modified as per direction of the PHO.

Showing proof of vaccination applies to all people 12+ who plan to use some of our services.

This applies to the following:

Admission to the weight room

Attending a fitness class/program

Attending adult indoor organized recreational sports and recreation programs such as rec hockey, pickleball, and table tennis.

Proof of vaccination is not required for:

Youth recreational sport for people 19 years old or younger. This would include recreational sport activities such as swim lessons, minor hockey, swim club, and figure skating.

Public swimming

Public skating

In addition to showing your official vaccine card, customers will also be required to show valid government issued photo ID. Customers 18 years of age or younger are not required to show ID.

Please ensure that you have your official proof of vaccination and valid government issued photo ID ready before entering the facility. Please allow extra time for processing.
